

Colborne Street Reconstruction

SERVICES PROVIDED

The City engaged CCTA to undertake the design, contract administration and inspection for reconstruction of a 1.2 km length of this 4-lane arterial roadway through the City's downtown. Designed and constructed in two segments, the scope of work included replacement of sewer and watermain and the addition of new decorative street lighting, boulevard trees and brick pavers.

The challenges presented by replacing all existing underground services and reconstructing the roadway while maintaining traffic flow and full access to businesses were significant as expected, however stakeholder involvement and cooperation facilitated by CCTA's efforts and communications kept issues to a minimum.

The first 600 m segment was completed in 2010 at a cost of \$3.25M. The second segment was completed in 2011 at a cost of \$2.34M.

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
