

Lefroy Servicing Project: Water & Sewer Works

SERVICES PROVIDED

This project involves the construction of 5.0 km of 500 mm dia. trunk watermain as an extension of the Innisfil Lakeshore Water Distribution System to feed the newly constructed Lefroy reservoir and booster station, as well as 2.0 km of 200/250 mm dia. sanitary sewer, 2.0 km of 250 mm dia. sanitary forcemain, replacement of seven significant road crossing culverts and upsizing of the Cedar Creek Road crossing culvert.

The project involves one bore and jack sewer crossing of 20th Sideroad and bore and jack sewer (300 mm dia. HDPE)and watermain (600 mm dia. HDPE) crossings of the Metrolinx (GO Transit) rail line.

Review agencies included: Lake Simcoe Region Conservation Authority, Metrolinx, Ministry of Environment & Climate Change, Town of Innisfil and Town of Bradford West Gwillimbury.
