SERVICES PROVIDED

The new Collingwood library designed by WGD Architects is located in the Town's downtown historic district. The exterior elevations blend in with the historic architecture of the area enclosing a modern, functional interior. The LEED Gold design features a green roof.

The structure consists of a steel frame with hollowcore precast slab floors and OWSJ roof framing. Reinforced concrete elevator and stairwell cores are designed to resist the lateral loads.

CCTA provided the civil and structural design. Working closely with the Architect we were able to optimize the design resulting in a tendered cost that was significantly under the project budget.
