

## Access, Parking & Circulation Review

Client: Georgian College (Barrie Campus)

### SERVICES PROVIDED

The *Georgian College Access, Parking & Circulation Review* addressed the transportation impacts associated with the proposed expansion of the College's Barrie campus. - full-time enrolment is expected to increase from 6,400 to 12,000 students over the next 20 years. The existing parking facilities and opportunities for improvement were addressed, as were future parking needs. Parking fees at the college were compared to similar institutes and facilities and the associated financial implications of increasing the parking supply were addressed. Recommendations were provided with respect to the parking fees to ensure full cost recovery. Vehicular operations at the three current access points were reviewed for the existing and future horizon years and necessary improvements identified. The need for additional access points was identified and three additional future access points were recommended, to serve different quadrants of the campus as development continues. Internal campus operations were considered, including both the road and pedestrian networks as they are currently developed and how they could be developed in future.
