

## Comprehensive Transportation Strategic Plan

### SERVICES PROVIDED

As a result of the rapidly growing recreation and tourism markets, the Town of The Blue Mountains is experiencing ever increasing transportation demands. AECOM in partnership with C.C. Tatham and Associates Ltd., was retained by the Town, the Ministry of Transportation of Ontario and the County of Grey to prepare a *Comprehensive Transportation Strategic Plan* that addressed the short, medium and long-term transportation needs for all levels of road infrastructure within the Town. Key objectives of the study included: identifying the impacts of existing and future development on the road network, conducting a traffic operational review within the Craigeith area, preparing traffic analysis for Highway 26, identifying access alternatives and preferred methods for Highway 26, identifying alternative transportation modes and other travel demand management tools, providing recommendations regarding the Town's road hierarchy, and developing capital cost estimates and a time schedule for the recommended improvements. A stakeholder consultation program was also undertaken to support and encourage stakeholder participation.
