

# McCutcheon Bridge Class EA Study

## SERVICES PROVIDED

The Town of Bracebridge retained CCTA to undertake a Schedule B Class Environmental Assessment Study for the McCutcheon Bridge, in the Village of Vankoughnet. Constructed in the early 1900s the bridge was deficient in width and load capacity, hydraulic capacity, and lacked appropriate guard rails. The Study addressed environmental, archeology, heritage, hydrology and hydraulic considerations. The Study concluded that the most appropriate solution was to replace the bridge with a longer span to reduce upstream flooding during the spring melt. Access to residents beyond the bridge will be provided by a temporary bridge during construction.

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
