SERVICES PROVIDED

The Municipality of Magnetawan retained CCTA to complete a *Road Needs Study and Asset Management Plan* in 2008. The Study included the detailed visual inspections of all roads, bridges, equipment and buildings. The current conditions, necessary improvements and the associated costs to undertake the recommended improvements/maintenance were identified. The recommended improvements and maintenance were prioritized to suit the Municipality's yearly budgets and schedule the improvements in a five year plan. The Asset Management Plan was completed in accordance with the requirements of the Public Sector Accounting Board Directive 3150 for the accounting for and reporting of tangible capital assets. In order to satisfy the requirements of PSAB 3150 all of the Municipality's assets were valued and the current replacement costs, historical purchase/construction costs and current values of the assets estimated. The Municipality will use the data collected and supplied by this study to guide their decisions relating to budgeting and scheduling maintenance and capital projects.

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
