The Township of Muskoka Lakes retained CCTA to complete their Road Needs Study in the spring of 2009, following up on our original Study in 2003, with updates in 2005 and 2007. The Study included the detailed visual inspections of all roads and bridges to assess current conditions, define necessary improvements and outline associated costs. A five year maintenance plan was prepared to prioritize improvements and replacements in accordance with the Township's budget. An Asset Management Plan was completed in accordance with the Public Sector Accounting Board Directive 3150 for the accounting for and reporting of tangible capital assets. The Asset Management Plan detailed the original, current and replacement values for all roads and bridges. The Township will use this Study to guide their decisions relating to budgets and scheduling of maintenance and capital projects.
