

Simcoe Road 21 Class Environmental Assessment

SERVICES PROVIDED

C.C. Tatham & Associates Ltd. is currently completing a Class Environmental Assessment to address improvements along Simcoe Road 21. Included in the scope of the project are intersection improvements at Simcoe Road 21 and 5 Sideroad and Simcoe Road 21 and Simcoe Road 4, as well as improvements to the Lover's Creek crossing. The project has been divided into two Class EA processes, addressing the road widening and intersection improvements separately in order to further expedite the process. Alternative improvement solutions being considered include: do nothing, reduce travel demands, alternative travel routes, reconstruction of the road and intersection improvements, and road widenings. Operational and geometric improvements are also being considered at the intersections with 5 Sideroad and Simcoe Road 4. Key issues include property impacts, impacts to the surrounding natural environment, stormwater management, replacement of the box culvert at Lover's Creek, and public and stakeholder input. Following the EA completion, CCTA has been retained to under the design and oversee implementation of the preferred solution.

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
