

Queen Street Urbanization

SERVICES PROVIDED

This project involves roadway improvements on Queen Street (formerly Highway 89) in the Village of Cookstown to address drainage deficiencies and pedestrian traffic safety concerns. The existing rural cross section will be upgraded to an urban design standard including curb and gutter, storm sewer, pavement resurfacing and sidewalks. Retrofitting road, sidewalk and drainage improvements within a developed section of Cookstown presented several design challenges due to the presence of above and below ground utilities coupled with property constraints. Several options to correct existing drainage deficiencies and remedy impacts to an adjacent private property were developed in consultation with the Town and the affected property owner. Detailed design and construction were completed in 2009.

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
