

Reconstruction of Muskoka Road 25

SERVICES PROVIDED

The District Municipality of Muskoka retained C. C. Tatham & Associates Ltd. to undertake a Schedule B Class Environmental Assessment Study to identify the most appropriate road improvement strategy for a 2.1 km section of Muskoka Road 25 given the concerns with poor horizontal and vertical curve geometry. A number of road realignment options were identified to accommodate improved road standards and minimize impacts to adjacent properties. The evaluation of options had to consider the constructability given the undulating rocky terrain, Lake Rosseau and potential impacts to the natural environment, and cost. Completion of the Class EA Study was achieved in 2010, and CCTA was subsequently retained to complete design of the preferred alternative and supervise construction of the works. Construction was completed in 2011 at a cost of \$2.2M.

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
