

Taylorwoods & Wallace Mills SWM Pond Retrofits

SERVICES PROVIDED

CCTA was retained by the Town of Innisfil to provide engineering services for the clean-out and restoration of three municipal stormwater management (SWM) ponds. The goal of these retrofit works is to increase the effectiveness of stormwater quantity and quality controls provided by the ponds, which treat stormwater runoff from surrounding residential developments. These retrofit works ensured the SWM ponds conform to Lake Simcoe Region Conservation Authority (LSRCA) regulations and the Environmental Compliance/Certificate of Approval issued by the Ministry of the Environment (MOE). CCTA was responsible for providing the following services:

- coordinating pre and post construction topographic survey;
- obtaining permits from LSRCA, DFO, MNR and MOE;
- detailed design;
- producing tender documents and contract drawings; and
- contract administration and construction inspection.

This project is complete with the exception of the ongoing 1-year maintenance period.
