

Fisher Field Soccer Park

SERVICES PROVIDED

Envision-Tatham (landscape architects) and CCTA were retained by the Town of Collingwood to design and provide design, construction supervision and contract administration services for a \$1.4M regional scale soccer facility at Fisher Field. The park accommodates three senior soccer pitches (63x100m), parking, public trails, seating and a stormwater management wetland.

CCTA completed the detailed design of the water, stormwater, electrical and lighting infrastructure required to service Fisher Field. The irrigation system water supply formed part of the design along with the surface and subsurface drainage systems that address the drainage issues typical of conventional soccer pitches. The drainage system design also included an infiltration wetland for the control and treatment of stormwater runoff.

Fisher Field Soccer Park was constructed in 2005 to premium design standards for soccer fields, which are currently being adopted by other municipalities across Ontario.

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
